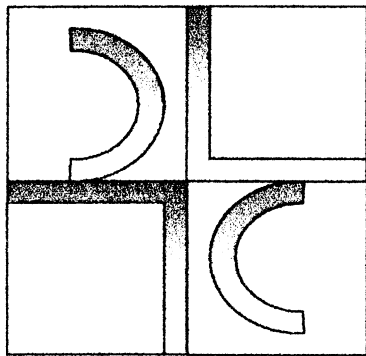

After our "Jubilee" walk to Lichfield where we were warmly welcomed, we are headed for Lastingham in Yorkshire where Chad took over the community on the death of his brother Cedd. We will cover about 165 miles which should not be too taxing for normally healthy people. We have a van to carry our luggage which does not amount to much as we live simply and sleep on the floor. Good sustaining food is provided, including a sandwich lunch, or you could treat yourself to a pub lunch. Our pilgrimage is Ecumenical.. We usually have one formal act of Christian worship daily and a number of informal prayer stops at churches on our way.

*All you need is to be over 15 years of age, unless accompanied by a responsible adult, able to WALK and a sense of FUN! Comfort and Joy? Joy is part of the Christian package holiday; comfort is more borderline but that is why we do it!*

The full two weeks cost £140. 'Unwaged' are charged £99 instead of £140. If this is too much please ask for help. Coach travel from Hove, Redhill or High Wycombe to Lichfield costs £10. The reverse from our destination, near Lastingham, likewise, £10. The return journey will drop off at Lichfield if required. You are welcome to join for a shorter period at £12 per night.

**To book please complete the slip below and return it with a £20 non-refundable deposit to the address stated. Places are limited due to hall sizes so do not delay. Bookings will close when all places are taken and in any event by 11<sup>th</sup> July. Anyone requiring overnight accommodation must book and pay in advance. Day pilgrims are welcome without notice.**
