Last year we walked about 180 miles from Guildford to Lichfield and considered the relationship between the Celtic St Chad and the Roman St Wilfrid. This year we take steps backward in time to an earlier scene in Chad's life at Lichfield where he succeeded his brother, Cedd. We will cover about 165 miles which should not be too taxing for normally healthy people. We have a van to carry our luggage which does not amount to much as we live simply and sleep on the floor. Good sustaining food is provided, including a sandwich lunch and *en route* drinks. Good humour is always in evidence too to cheer on tiring legs.

Our pilgrimage is Ecumenical. We worship together daily as Christians of different traditions, pausing for prayer stops at places of worship on our way – much as pilgrims have always done. We also get spiritual uplift from the kindness shown to us by the communities we meet.

All you need is to be over 15 years of age, unless accompanied by a responsible adult, able to WALK and a sense of FUN! Comfort and Joy? Joy is part of the Christian package holiday; comfort is more borderline but that is why we do it!

The full two weeks costs £140. Coach travel from Hove, Redhill or High Wycombe to Lichfield costs £10. The reverse from Our destination, near Lichfield, likewise, £10. The return journey will drop off at Lichfield if required. 'Unwaged' are charged £99 instead of £140. If this is too much please ask for help.
