THE SALISBURY PILGRIMAGE Saturday 16th – Sunday 31st August 2008



Each summer the Diocese of Arundel and Brighton organises an ecumenical walk to a place, shrine or area exploring a particular theme or aspect of our faith and Christian heritage. What we rediscover, year after year, is the amazing personal and community value of going on a pilgrimage as our medieval forebears did, where the journey, walking, laughing, sharing, praying, singing, etc. is as important as the destination. We stop at a pub for lunch and sleep on the floors of church, school or community halls. We try to walk on footpaths not roads.

Our 34th pilgrimage is from Evesham in Worcestershire, which we last visited 25 years ago, to Salisbury, where the Cathedral is celebrating the 750th anniversary of its consecration. Each day we

will reflect on phrases from the Magnificat (Luke 1:46-55).

Every day we worship together as a Christian community, not only journeying together, but also growing together in Christ-centred friendships. We stop to pray in the churches we pass, many of which are of architectural and historical interest, and all of which

bring us into contact with the communities we

are passing through. Services vary in style and formality.

REQUIREMENTS: All you have to be is over 15 (unless accompanied by an adult) and be fit enough to walk an average of about 16 miles per day at a moderate pace — and a sense of humour is useful.

TRANSPORT: Our luggage is taken from hall to hall by van. A coach will run from Redhill to Evesham (£15 per person) and from Salisbury to Redhill (£12 per person).

Cost: The cost is only £110 for the whole way (£90 for under 21's), 7+ nights at £11 per night, 1 to 6 nights at



£13 per night. Breakfast, sandwiches for lunch and an evening meal are all included in the cost of the pilgrimage, which is organised by past pilgrims on a voluntary basis.
